

Cooler Master Intros Quick Fire XTi Keyboard

Cooler Master launches the Quick Fire XTi-- a mechanical keyboard promising to provide "the ultimate in minimal design and sleek simplicity," as well as multi-colour LED backlighting.



Aimed at gamers and enthusiast customers, the Quick Fire XTi features Cherry MX switches, on-the-fly macro and profile support, customisable multicolour per-key backlighting, NKRO, 1000Hz polling, Windows key lock and a detachable gold plated cable.

The keys are UV-coated for long-lasting use, and customers can choose between red, brown or blue Cherry MX switches as per tactile preference. Meanwhile backlighting comes in red and blue, creating a choice of 35 colours per key, as well as lighting modes such as wave, breathing and responsive effects.

Cooler Master says more lighting effects will be available with future firmware releases.

Four dedicated profile keys and onboard memory allow fast backlight switching and macro recording without need for PC-based software.

The Quick Fire XTi is available in Europe from October 2015.
