PC case maker Lian Li launches the set of peripherals first shown back at CES 2016-- the KB-01 Bluetooth keyboard, the KM-01 wireless keyboard and mouse combo, and the PT-M5 oversized mouse pad.



Both keyboards feature chiclet-style keys backed with scissor switches arranged in a standard 104 key layout complete with combo media keys and LEDs for num lock, caps lock and battery level. The underside of the keyboards houses power and pairing buttons together with rubber non-slip feet and flip-out rear stands.

As the name suggests the KB-01 connects to just about any device, including PCs, Macs, smartphones and tablets, via Bluetooth. Wired connectivity is also available via mini USB port. Power comes through x2 standard AAA batteries, and colour options include blue, gold or silver.

Meanwhile the KM-01 foregoes Bluetooth in favour of a bundled USB 2.4GHz wireless receiver, allowing for lower latency if with poorer battery life. It is otherwise identical in shape and size to the KB-01, and ships with a wireless mouse. Compatibility is limited to PCs (Windows 7 or newer) and Macs (OS X 10.10 or higher) but colour options are more varied in black, green, red, blue, gold and silver.

The final Lian Li product announced is the PT-M5 mouse pad-- a self-explanatory product made with fabric and natural rubber measuring 780 x 300mm. the rubber allows for waterproofing and the whole thing is rollable for easy transport or storage.
