

Gerhard Schulz Leaves Ingram Micro

Ingram Micro announces European leader Gerhard Schulz is leaving the company for as yet unspecified reasons. No word is available on any potential replacements, either.

Schulz served at Ingram for over 15 years, and has been president of European Technology Solutions since 2013. Prior to his promotion he led the Ingram distribution business across DACHH, covering operations in Germany, Austria, Switzerland and Hungary. He also served as managing director of Ingram's German business, as well as other senior sales posts in the country.

The past 2 years saw Schulz lead a restructure of Ingram EMEA operations, with each country having a dedicated chief executive overseeing a national business split in 4 areas, namely traditional distribution, cloud services, lifecycle services and e-commerce. The restructure also involved the closing of the Ingram Brussels HQ and the opening of a centralised service centre in Sofia, Bulgaria.
