

If your customers want to use an eReader for their bathtime reading Kobo might have just the solution at IFA 2014-- the Aura H2O, the first eReader from the company with IP67 certification.

As well as protection from the hazards of dust and water it carries an extra-large 6.8-inch Carta elnk display with 1430x1080 resolution, as well as a battery promising up to 2 months of reading time.

Further features include 4GB of built-in storage (expandable to 32GB via microSD card), Pocket integration and a revised UI making it even easier to use for those familiar with Kindle devices.

It should be available in European markets from October 2014.
