Samsung announces the Notebook 9 Pro at Computex 2017-- a Windows 10 convertible laptop with a built-in slot for the stowing of an included S Pen stylus.



Available in 13.3- or 15-inch sizes, the Notebook 9 Pro features a 360-degree hinge, allowing the users to switch between notebook and tablet use modes. It carries a 7th generation Intel Core i7 processor and 256GB SSD storage, with the 13.3-inch model including 8GB RAM and the 15-inch model featuring 15GB RAM and Radeon 540 graphics.

Also included is fast charging via USB-C, although Samsung does not specify how long it takes to fully charge the 54Whr battery inside the device. Another option is facial recognition via Windows Hello.

As for the S Pen, it is identical to the one found with the Galaxy Tab S3 and Galaxy Book. It has a 0.7mm nib, detects up to 4000 levels of pressure and supports both Windows Ink and Samsung Air Command input.

Samsung is still to announce the shipping dates for the Notebook 9 Pro.
