Samsung announces the next Galaxy Tab device-- the Galaxy Tab S4, a convertible tablet complete with stylus and Samsung DeX functionality the company says is "designed for people who want to do more on the go."



Clearly aimed as a rival to the likes of the iPad Pro and Microsoft Surface, the Galaxy Tab S4 features a 10.5-inch 2560x1600 Super AMOLED and runs on an octa-core Qualcomm Snapdragon 835 processor. Further tech specs include 4GB RAM, 64/256GB storage (expandable via microSD card), Dolby Atmos audio and a 7300mAh battery with fast charging. Connectivity comes through wifi, Bluetooth 5.0, LTE and a USB-C port.

On the productivity side the tablet includes an S Pen stylus, and can be turned into a notebook device through the Book Cover Keyboard (sold separately). Users can switch to a desktop-style UI through Samsung DeX, with multiple windows, keyboard shortcuts and mouse support, and the USB-C port allows connection to an external monitor via compatible HDMI to USB-C multi-port adapter.
