The OWC Envoy Pro EX is an external USB-C SSD the company claims is the fastest around, with NVMe-based storage allowing for transfer speeds reaching up to 980MB/s, all within a pocket-sized package.



Such performance, the company adds, allows the drive to handle 4K video editing, all with silent fanless operation. The drive comes in IP67-rated casing able to withstand dust and up to 30 minutes in 1m of water. It is compatible with both Mac and Windows PCs, and also direct-connects to devices such as USB-C Blackmagic cameras.
